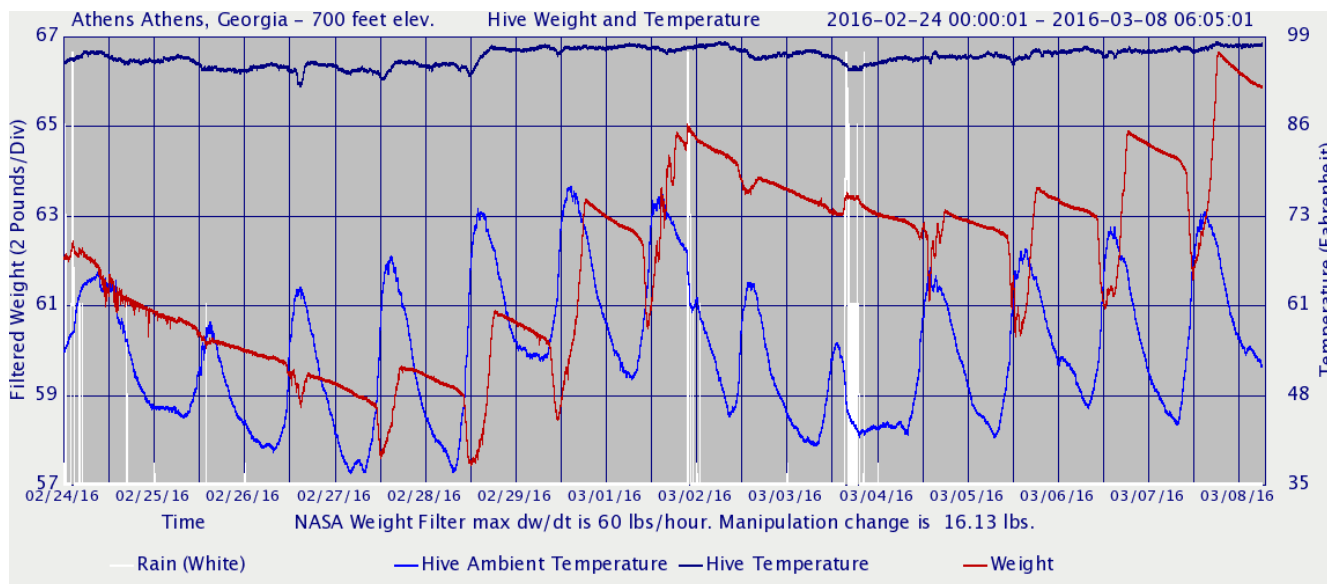


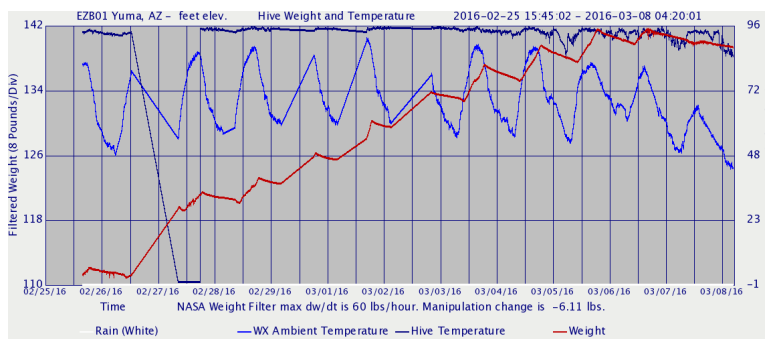
# Flows start in South. Swarming continues in California.

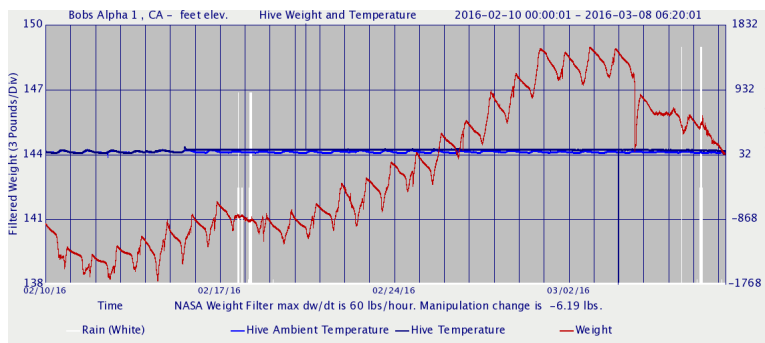
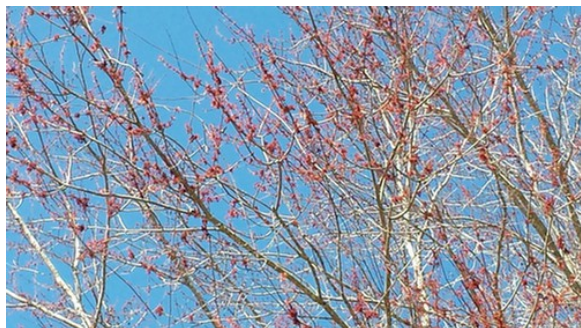
EZB2 in Yuma, AZ has been reporting strong gains for the last several weeks.
